

Dr. Runako Whittaker, appointed by the [State Superintendent of Public Instruction](#), is a native of Seattle. For the past 21 years she has lived in Tulsa and has been practicing in the North Tulsa community since 2003. After graduating with honors from Clark Atlanta University with a degree in biology, she attended the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) School of Medicine. She entered a preliminary residency program for a year at UCSF -Fresno before being accepted to the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine- Tulsa residency program in Pediatrics. Dr. Whittaker was a staff pediatrician at Morton Comprehensive Health Services. She later became the pediatrician and medical Director of Westview Medical Center's first-ever pediatric clinic, Westview Pediatric Care. Dr. Whittaker is a member of Metropolitan Baptist Church, The Tulsa Chapter of The Links, Inc., The Oklahoma Black Physicians Alliance, The American Academy of Pediatrics and a board member of The Heather Burns Memorial Scholarship Fund. Her honors include Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.
