A 30-year veteran of federal government relations, Lillian currently serves as Director of Federal Affairs for *Health Care Service Corporation (Blue Cross Blue Shield of IL TX MT OK NM)*. She has led government affairs strategy for some of the nation's most heavily regulated industries, including Oil & Gas, PBM and Biopharmaceutical Manufacturing. Her distinguished legislative background includes 18 years' service on Capitol Hill, where she was a Chief of Staff for four Democratic Members of Congress and Deputy Chief Counsel for Oversight and Investigations for the House Judiciary Committee, under the late Committee Chairman John Conyers, Jr.

A graduate of the University of North Texas and Southern Methodist University Dedman School of Law, Lillian has advised numerous presidential campaigns, from Obama 2008 to Kerry-Edwards 2004 and Gore-Lieberman 2000.
